

Cueing Hierarchy for People with Word-Finding Difficulties

1. "What's this called?" (Point to the object)
2. "What is the function of this object?"
3. Clinician or caregiver demonstrates using the object.
4. Clinician or caregiver states the function of the object.
5. State and demonstrate function of object.
6. Sentence completion.
7. Sentence completion plus silently articulated first phoneme (letter) of the object.
8. Sentence completion plus vocalized first phoneme (letter) of the object.
9. Sentence completion plus first two phonemes (letters) of object.
